- 1) Subdural/extradural or traumatic brain injury evident on CT.
- 2) Persistent cognitive impairment, e.g., post traumatic amnesia (>1 hour in duration) following head injury.
- 3) Recurrent Emergency Department attendance with neurological problems following head injury, in the absence of chronic drug or alcohol abuse.
